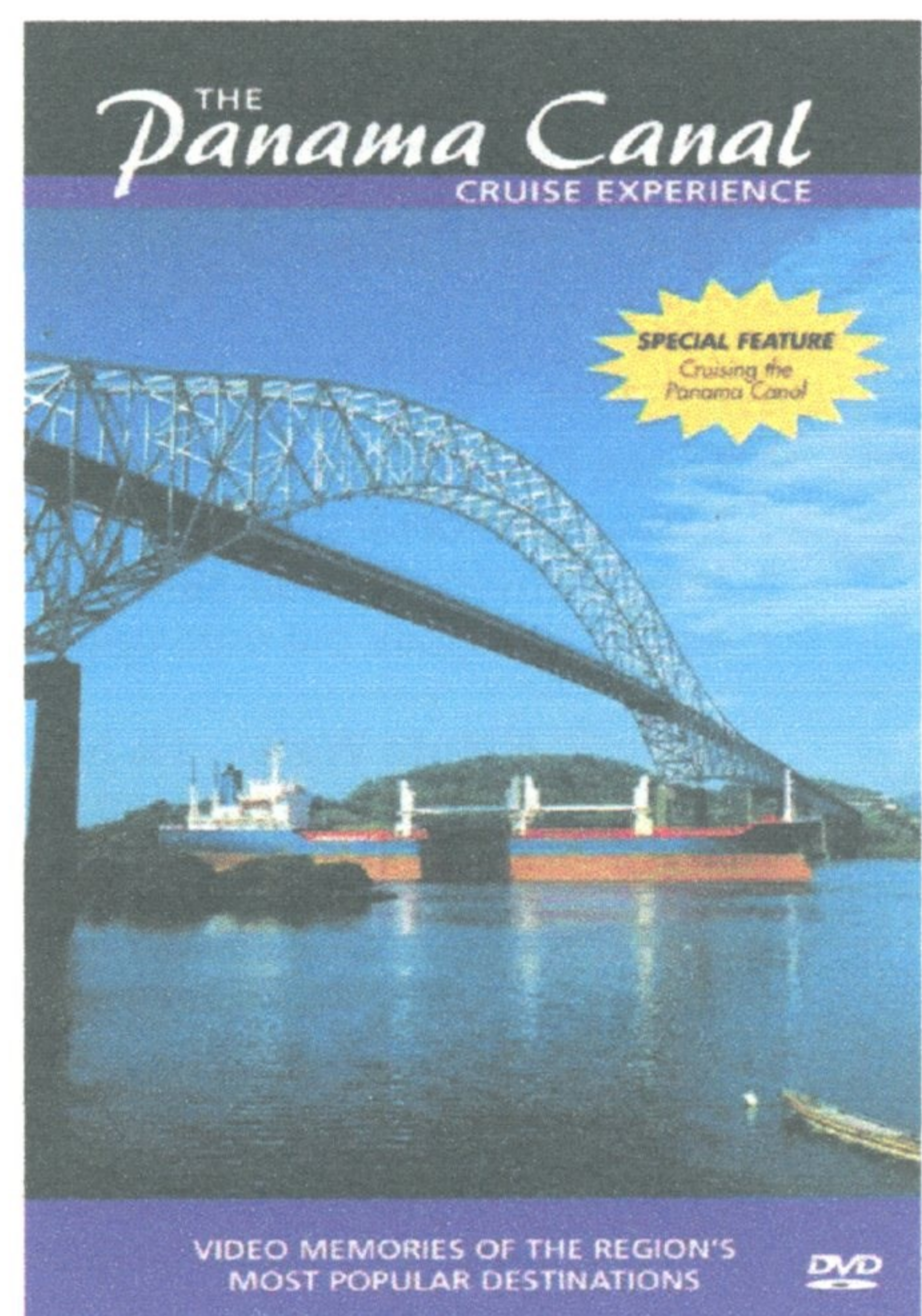

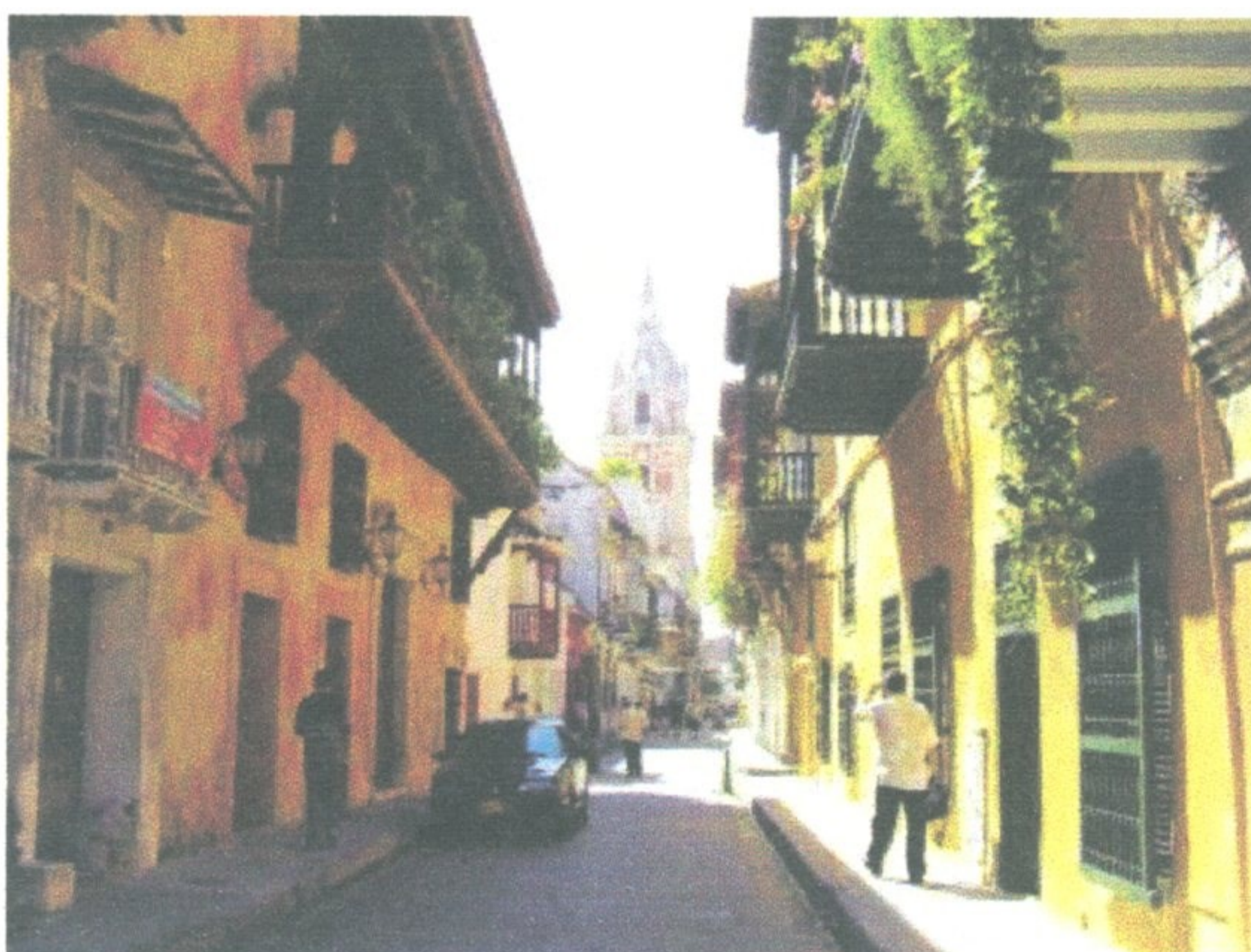

i Transiting the Gatun Lock and also being able to tour the country of Panama are the best of both worlds and your itinerary allows you to do both. All guests on the Zuiderdam will transit through the Gatun Locks once in the morning. Upon anchoring in Gatun Lake, only guests who have booked a Holland America Line excursion may go ashore due to Panamanian government regulations. Therefore the only way to truly see and experience the country of Panama is by going on tour. After the tours have departed, the ship will go back the same way she came, down the Gatun Locks to the Caribbean sea where she will dock in Colón in the latter part of the afternoon. All tours end in Colón. *You may arrive back at the port before the Zuiderdam docks.*

Due to the canal transits being regulated by the Panamanian Authority, tour departure times and durations are subject to change at any time without prior notice and are determined by the ship's actual transit through the Gatun Locks.





Please note that Panama is a developing country and bumpy roads and potholes are a part of the experience. We use the best available transportation, including some buses offering only a forced air system. Also, as this is a tender pier, the platform where the tender drops you is a very small space and has a very steep ramp to walk up. The distance to walk to board the buses is approx. 100 - 500 feet. *Guests with mobility issues are strongly advised to see the shore excursions staff regarding the walk.*

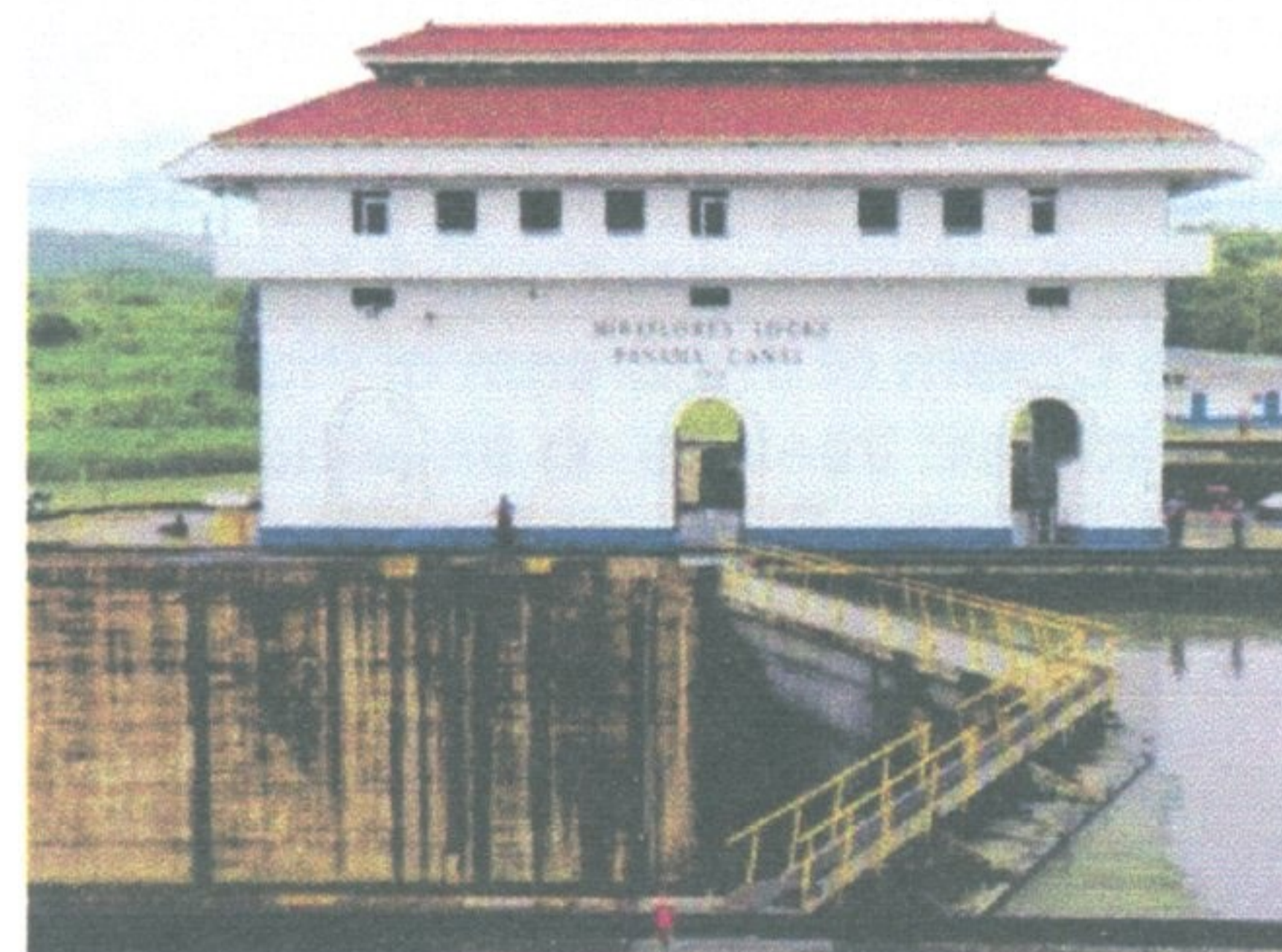

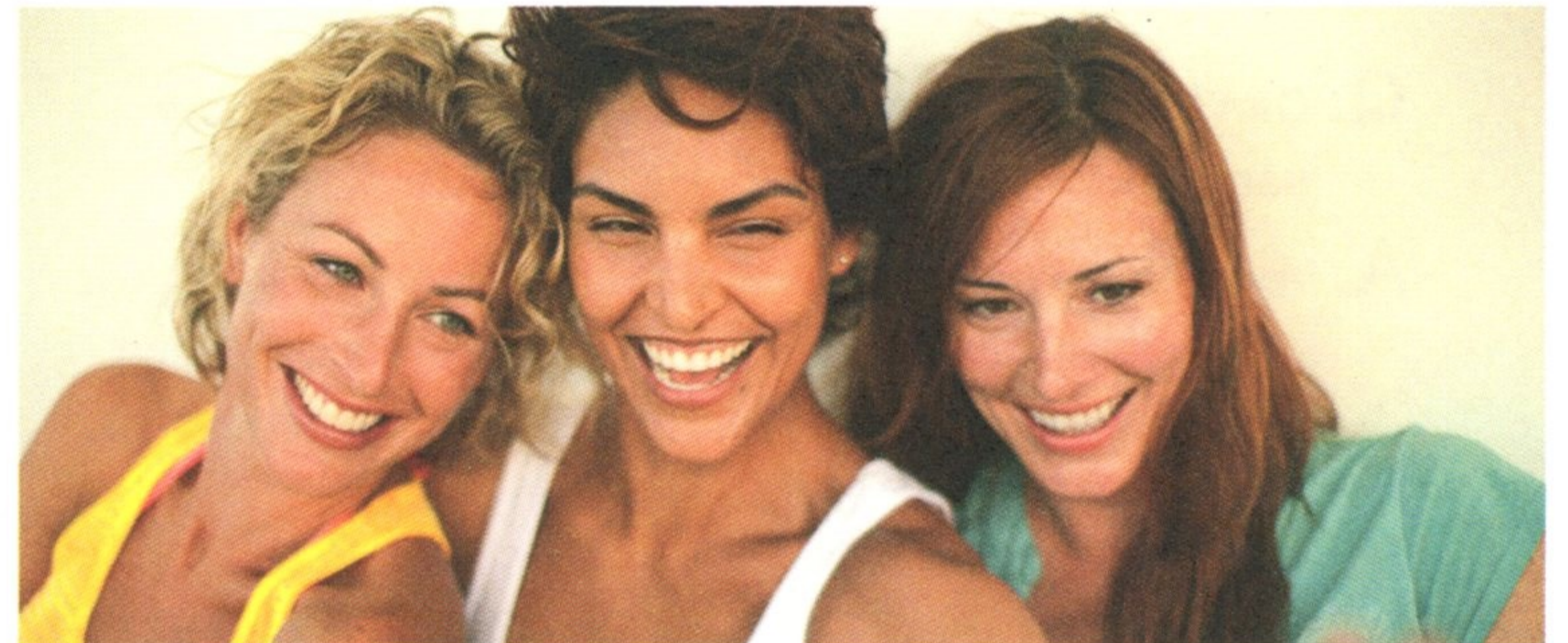
