Q. Can I travel with my friends and/or family on the same bus?

A. Yes! Please have your entire group check in together at the meeting location and our staff will arrange to have you seated on the same bus. Large groups may be split depending on transportation capacity.

Q. What if I have a disability or require special accommodations on my tour(s)?

A. Please speak with a member of the shore excursions team so we can review your tour options and best meet your needs.

Q. What if I change my mind or need to cancel a tour that I have requested on the order form?

A. If you change your mind after submitting your order form, visit the Shore Excursions Office or call extension 96 during office hours. Please note that some tours are non-refundable.

Q. Where do I meet for my tour?

A. The location, meeting time and departure time are noted on your tour ticket(s).

Q. I am traveling on a Collectors' Voyage. Can I book tours for all segments of my voyage?

A. If you are a Collectors' Voyage guest, you may book tours for the first segment of your cruise on the enclosed order form. For tours occurring during your second segment, you will receive a new order form by the first day of the second segment. You can also inquire with the shore excursions team, as there may be the opportunity to book in advance.

In this regard, it is important to keep in mind that shore excursion operators are subject to the laws of their own country including with respect to accommodating the needs of passengers with disabilities. In most foreign countries, the laws are not as stringent as those in the United States. Passengers under 18 years of age will not be able to participate in shore excursion operators reserve the right to deny participation to passengers based on such criteria as they may establish.
