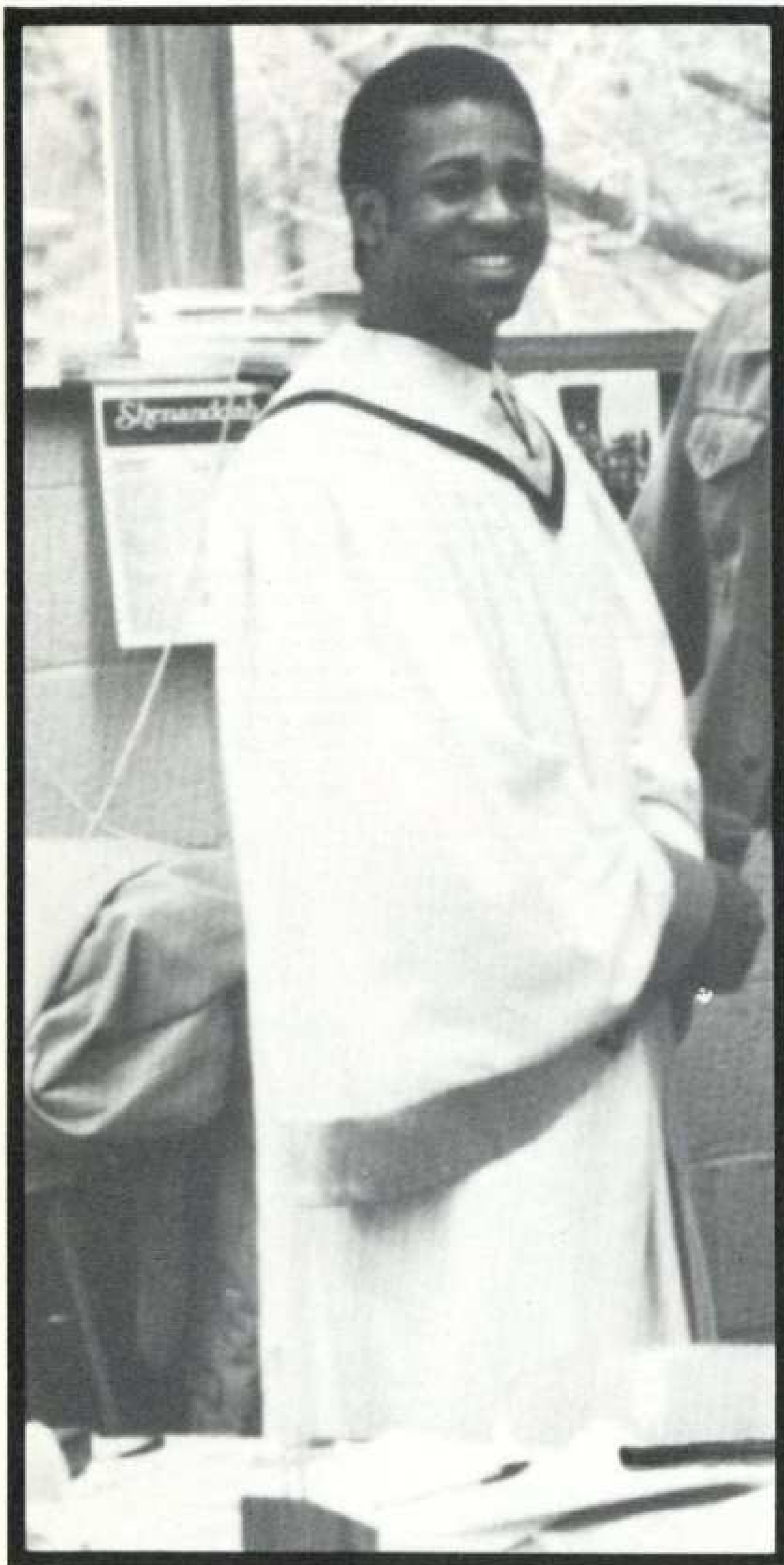
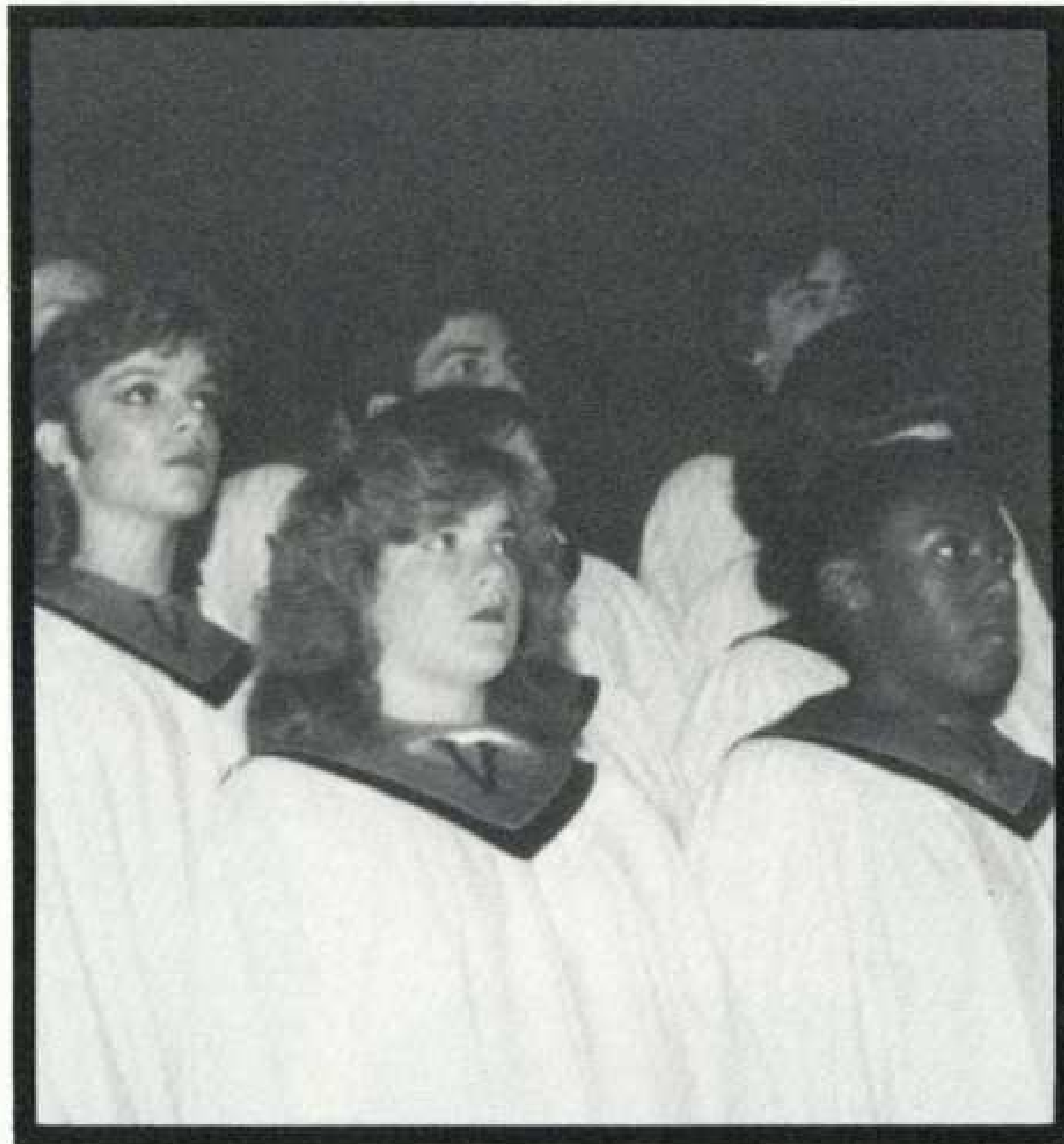
### Computers . . . Are They Taking Over The World?

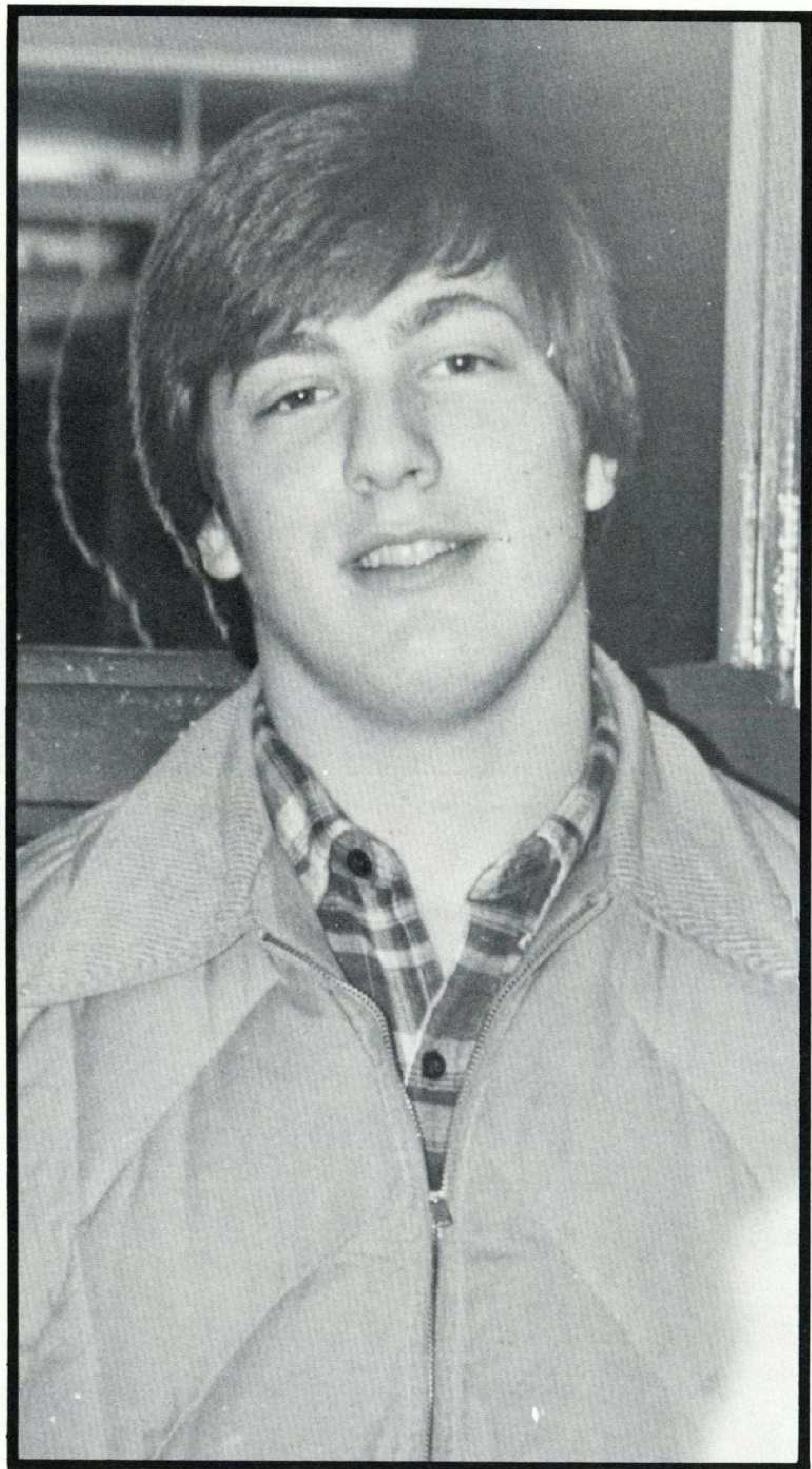
## *A Foreigner Makes His Home At Valley*
